



## MagiCard Guide

### Language setting for Driver and Printer

Follow the steps below to change the Language setting of the Driver and Printer

#### **DRIVER LANGUAGE**

The driver will get the language from the system language on your PC, but you can change it manually:

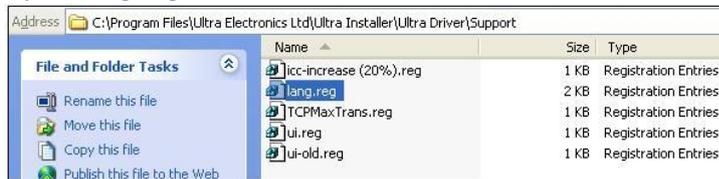
Depending on your current driver version, Go to:

<C:\Program Files\Ultra Electronics Ltd\Ultra Installer\Ultra Driver\Support>

Or

[C:\Program Files \(x86\)\Ultra ID\support](C:\Program Files (x86)\Ultra ID\support)

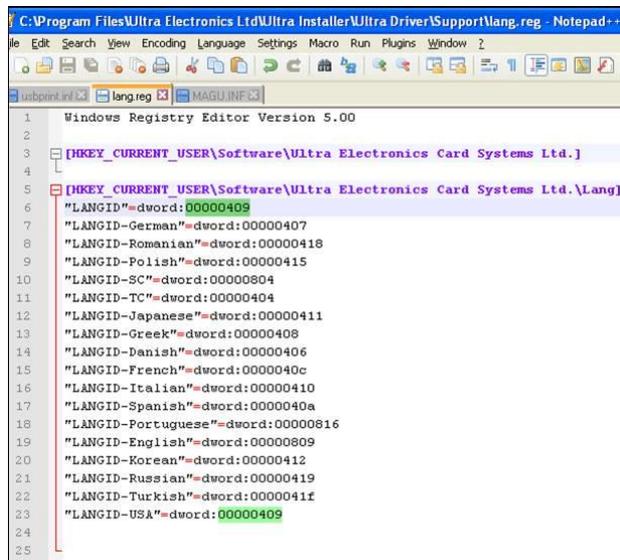
Open **Lang.reg** in an editor (like Notepad, or Notepad++)



Set the last 3 digits to your required language in “dword” at the top:

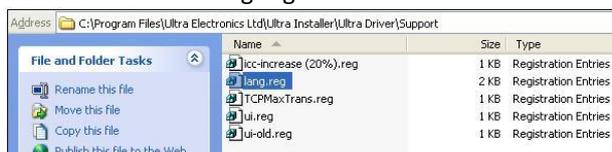
409 = USA English.

"LANGID"=dword:00000409

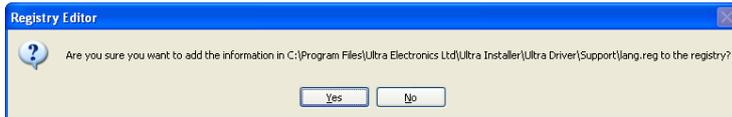


Then **SAVE** and close

Now double click lang.reg:



Choose YES:



Click OK:

## **PRINTERS LANGUAGE**

The **Printer** will get its language from the **Driver**.

It can also be changed using a Quick Command from:

- ID Card Printer [Support Utility](#)
- Or from the **Tools tab** in Printer Properties within the latest versions of the driver.

The available languages (for the printer's display) are;

- 0 - ENGLISH
- 1 - PORTUGUESE
- 2 - FRENCH
- 3 - GERMAN
- 4 - SPANISH
- 5 - ITALIAN
- 6 - POLISH
- 7 - ROMANIAN

In the Quick Commands box, type the following;

**LNG0** then click **Send**



This will set the printer's language to **English**.  
Substitute the digit for your preferred language

### **Please Note:**

The next time a print is sent from the driver, the printer will inherit the driver language.
